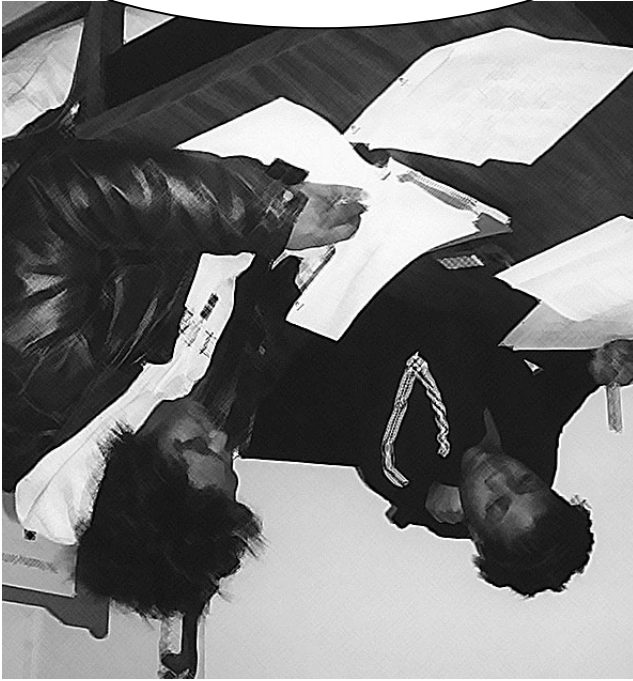

The Over-The-Rhine Learning Center touches the lives of hundreds of area residents with one-to-one reading tutoring, G.E.D. test prep, computer lab & classes, job search support, telephone and fax use. The Center's Community Computer Lab serves over 150 users a year, offering free access for e-mailing and internet use as well as basic computer skills classes, job search, and resume assistance. With a high school drop-out rate in Over-the-Rhine of 45%, the Center empowers OTR residents to make things different in their own lives!

Besides literacy-related offerings, the Center connects people to the resources offered next door at First Lutheran Church such as clothing, food pantry items, and pastoral counseling.
